- 1. Remove the endcap from the lancing
- 2. Loosen the round protective cap on a lancet by rotating it 1/4 turn, but do not remove it.

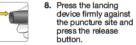
- 3. Insert the lancet firmly into the lancing device until it comes to a full stop.

- 5. Replace the endcap.

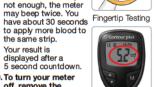

Setting Your Meter to **Advanced Mode**

To set your meter to Advanced Mode, and take advantage of meal markers and other available features:

- 1. Press M to turn your meter on.
- 2. Press and hold ▲ or ▼ for 3 seconds.
- 3. L-1 will flash.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to change to L-2.
 - 5. Press M to set.
